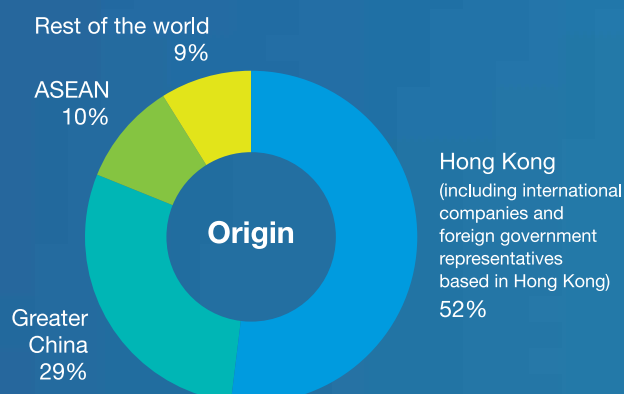
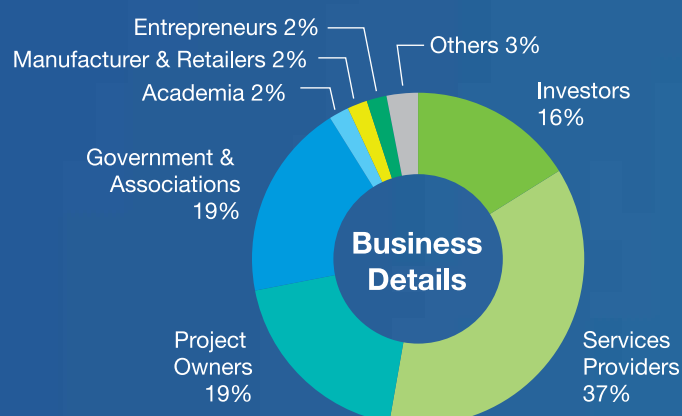

One-to-one Business Matching Meetings

During the 2019 Summit, over **700** One-to-one Business Matching Meetings were arranged featuring more than **240** investment projects. Summit participants were able to meet with potential business partners based on their shared areas of interest through pre-arranged meetings. Project owners & operators, investors and services providers from around the world were gathered at this premium platform to build new connections and crystallise business opportunities.

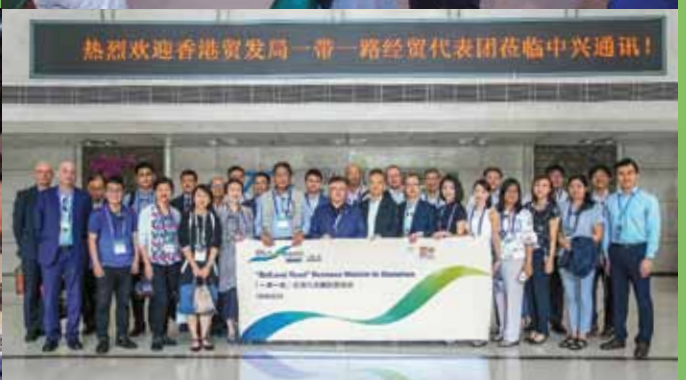
Side visits in Hong Kong
